

## **Board Member and Officer Recruitment**

The Board of the New Mexico Perinatal Collaborative (NMPC) works with the staff to guide the organization's planning, program development, and resource allocation. NMPC is a 501c3 organization that envisions statewide health equity through the provision of safe, high-quality, and respectful reproductive, perinatal, and neonatal care for New Mexico families. Our mission is to convene stakeholders to achieve health equity and high-quality outcomes through the promotion of evidence-based reproductive, perinatal, and neonatal healthcare practices that

- o Facilitate collaboration with communities and across healthcare disciplines
- o Focus on quality improvement strategies
- o Empower healthcare teams statewide to offer the highest quality care, and
- o Ensure provision of holistic and culturally respectful care.

The NMPC Board has board member and the following officer positions available for election in July 2022.

## Secretary

- Keeps records of Board actions, including Board and Executive Committee meeting minutes
- Provides agendas, minutes, and other materials as needed to the board
- Ensures corporate records are maintained

## Treasurer-Elect

- Ensures accurate financial records are kept and maintained
- Leads the Finance Committee
- Presents a financial report at each Board meeting and assists in annual budget preparation

## **President-Elect**

- Assists the Board President in discharging the duties of that office
- Serves as President in the absence of the Board President
- May lead a programs committee if any

Board members are elected to one two-year term. They may be considered for one additional consecutive like term following a review of attendance at Board meetings, service on Board committees, and promotion of NMPC initiatives. The President-Elect shall serve as President-Elect for one year, President for one year and Immediate Past-President for one year. The Secretary and the Treasurer shall both serve a term of two years.

The board meets quarterly. Officers also serve on the Executive Committee which meets in alternate months and as needed. All positions are supported by the Executive Director and staff.
